To apply, please submit the following:

- 1) A current resume.
- 2) Answers to the following questions. Please begin each on a fresh sheet.
  - i) Tell me something about yourself, something that will make you come alive as a person. You get to decide what you reveal and at what length.
  - ii) Why do you want to take this program? How did you learn about it? Give me as much detail as possible. If any part of the syllabus spoke to you strongly, which part and why? If anyone recommended it to you, who? And why?
  - iii) What specific – list them – learning outcomes would you like to take away from this program? An example of such an outcome is, “I would like to learn how to stop being bothered by what I think others are thinking about me.”
  - iv) What are you hesitant about? Are you nervous or concerned about anything you read in the syllabus or heard from others?
  - v) What really, really, really and truly matters to you? Why?
  - vi) How will others who take this program benefit from having you in it?
  - vii) This program requires an enormous commitment of time as well as emotional and psychic energy. If your participation slacks off, you will be doing a disservice to yourself as well as to other members of class. Are you fully prepared to take responsibility to make this a resoundingly successful experience for yourself as well as for others?

**Suggested length: One page is too short and twenty pages is too long for all questions combined.**

**Please be prepared for an interview, if necessary.**
